HOW TO PRAY THE ROSARY

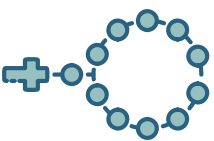
1. Make the **Sign of the Cross** and pray the **Apostles' Creed**.

2. On the first large bead, pray: **Our Father**. On the next three small beads, pray **Hail Mary**. Then, pray the **Glory Be**.

The Rosary is made up of 5 decades. Each decade helps us think about a special moment in Jesus' life with Mary.

3. For every decade:

- Announce the Mystery
- Pray **Our Father**
- Pray **10 Hail Marys**
- Pray the **Glory Be**
- Pray the **Fatima Prayer**
